What you **HAVE** to know...



- ❑ The choice of the track is **mandatory**
- ❑ You have to choose one of the 3 tracks offered:
Economics, Finance, Management
- ❑ tracks need a minimum number of students to start

Elective courses

What you **HAVE** to know...



- The choice of the electives is **mandatory**
- You can only choose 2 courses out of the list the system proposes
- Courses need a minimum number of students to start
- Maximum number of students admitted: 100
- Check very carefully the timetable before making your choices to be sure that there is no clash!

For students going abroad...

Erasmus, Free mover, Summer School

- Students who wish to take **an elective course while studying abroad** in the context of an International Exchange Program, the Free Mover Program or a Summer School and to sit the associated exam must select the general:

"Exam taken abroad" option.

- The exam - if passed - will be included in the student's academic record and the student will be awarded the number of credits that their own degree program specifications attribute to electives.
- It should be noted that it is necessary that courses have already been approved in accordance with the procedures laid down for every mobility program: <http://www.luiss.it/esperienze-allestero>
- Should the exam for the elective course taken abroad not be passed, the student must inform the Student Office of the elective and associated exam that they intend to take at LUISS from among the courses on the list taught in their own Department that are not already full.

- Login to your web self-service page between July 20 and 25 Choose 1 or 2 additional courses out of the list
- Save your choices!!
- check if your last choices have been inserted correctly: logout and then login again!

You can login and change your choices only between July 20 and 25



Additional courses

What you **should** know...



- The choice of the additional courses is **OPTIONAL**
- If you want to choose additional courses you can make the selection out of the list proposed
- Check very carefully the timetable before making your choice to be sure that there is no clash!
- You cannot decide to insert additional courses after July 25

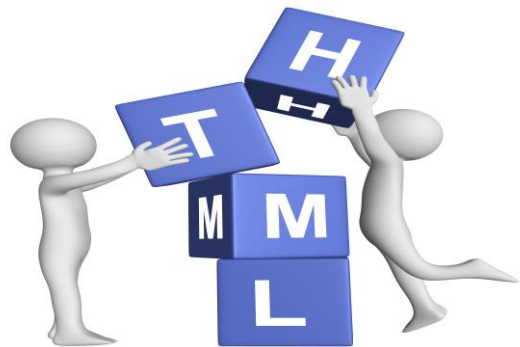
Additional courses What we propose...
