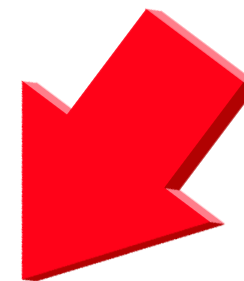
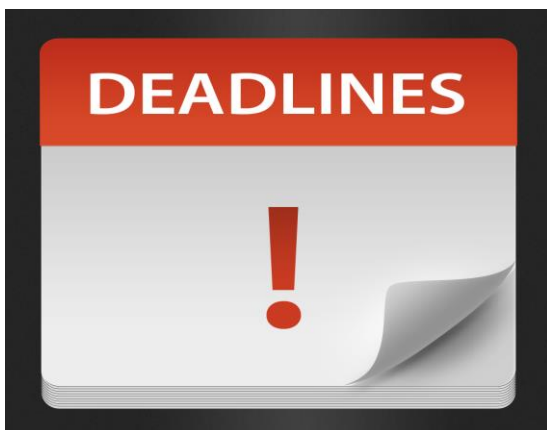

# Elective courses

What you **HAVE** to do....



- Login to your web self-service page between June 28 and July 5
- Choose 2 elective courses out of the list
- Save your choice!!
- Check if your choice has been inserted correctly: logout and then login again!



You can login and change your choice only between June 28 and July 5

# Elective courses

What you **HAVE** to know...



- The choice of the elective courses is **mandatory**
- You can only choose courses out of the list
- Courses need a minimum number of students to start
- Maximum number of students admitted: 100
- Check very carefully the timetable before making your choices to be sure that there is no clash!

After July 5 you won't be able to change your choices!!

## Erasmus, Free Mover, Summer School:



- The exam - if passed - will be included in the student's academic record and the student will be awarded the number of credits that their own degree program specifications attribute to electives.
- It should be noted that it is necessary that courses have already been approved in accordance with the procedures laid down for every mobility program: <http://www.luiss.it/esperienze-allestero>
- Should the exam for the elective course taken abroad not be passed, the student must inform the Student Office of the elective and associated exam that they intend to take at LUISS from among the courses on the list taught in their own Department that are not already full.

## Additional courses

What you **should** know...



NB!

- The choice of the additional courses is **OPTIONAL**
- If you want to choose additional courses you can make the selection out of the list proposed
- Check very carefully the timetable before making your choice to be sure that there is no clash!
- You cannot decide to insert additional courses after July 25

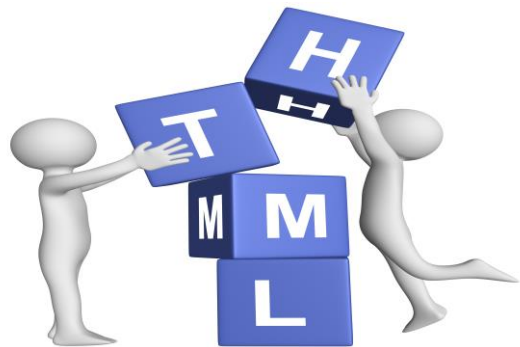
## Additional courses What we propose...
